

Queen Elizabeth The Queen Mother Hospital



Parking:

Visitor parking (Ramsgate Road side) - after entering from the highway, to your left you have a visitor car park with 37 bays; or if you follow the one-way road past main reception and turn right at the crossroads (past the Hospice) you will reach another visitor car park with 69 bays (entrance on right).

Visitor parking (St Peter's Road side) - enter from the highway opposite Maternity and immediately turn right for a 115 bay car park (at busy times spaces will often be available at the Maternity end of this car park).

Disabled parking (Ramsgate Road side) – drive straight towards A&E and turn left at the bend, and then left again (13 bays).

Disabled parking (St Peter's Road side) - either enter opposite the St Peter's Road entrance (29 bays), or opposite Maternity, turning left on entry (not through barriers) and follow road round (13 bays).

Charges:

£2.30 for the first hour

20p for every additional 12 minutes after the first hour

Maximum charge of £10 per 24-hour period

Free for up to 20 minutes.

Patient drop-off bays are located directly outside the hospital entrances. These are intended for drop-off and pick-up only and we would ask you not to wait or park there as space is limited.

Public Transport: Stagecoach 'Loop' buses provide a frequent service between the hospital and other Thanet towns such as Margate, Cliftonville, Broadstairs and Ramsgate. The hospital is also served by buses from Canterbury, Birchington, Westgate and Northdown Park on route 8 or 8A.
